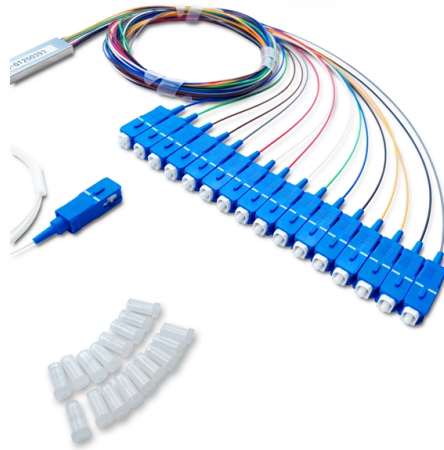


8-core optical cable stripping and splicing process
