

Can a 12V DC monitoring power cable be run through a low-voltage cable tray



Overview

The NEC permits power and signal cables in the same tray under specific conditions. Power cables rated 600V or less and Class 2 or Class 3 signal cables may share a tray if separated by a fixed barrier or if the power cables are separated from the signal.

Why It Matters: Power conductors can induce noise into nearby limited energy and communications cabling, creating latency, packet loss, or disrupted signaling. EMI risk increases with parallel runs and long shared pathways. Best Practice: Maintain TIA-569-E spacing between power and LE circuits. Cable tray is the preferred wiring method for industrial facilities, data centers, and large commercial buildings where routing dozens or. For most low-voltage AC and DC applications, the maximum acceptable voltage drop is 10%. The charts below provide the maximum cable distance in metres for common wire gauges based on this 10% limit. If you run a 12V wire for 10, 20, 50, 100, or even 200 feet, the voltage drop will be significant (since 12V is one of the lowest voltages; compared to 120V, or 220V, for example).
