 - OM5 (wideband multimode 50/125 μm): Lime green jacket, supporting multiple wavelengths for advanced data center applications .

Connector and Boot Colors

Connector boots also help identify fiber type and polish:

- Single-mode fiber: Blue boot for UPC polish, green boot for APC polish .
