Another method of connecting optical fibers is termination or connectorization, which consists of processing the end of a fiber optic bundle so that it can be connected to other fibers or devices through fiber optic. Mechanical splices do not require electricity. They may be used to convey voice, video and data. The fiber optic cables have a glass core covered with cladding, coatings, and, typically, Kevlar membranes to add strength.
