- Ferrules: Two 1.25 mm ceramic ferrules align and protect the fiber cores.
- Body/Housing: Plastic shell securing ferrules and internal springs.
- Latch: Push-pull clip for easy connection and disconnection.
- Boot: Protects the cable at the exit and reduces strain.
- Duplex Clip: Holds two simplex connectors together for a duplex pair.
