Common Hanging Hardware

J-Hooks: Widely used for indoor cable management, J-hooks support large bundles of fiber optic cables, reducing stress and minimizing signal interference. They are suitable for structured cabling in commercial buildings, data centers, and industrial environments, and come in various sizes and materials for different load capacities and cable diameters . **Clamps and Cable Hangers:** Clamps, including beam clamps, magnetic clamps, and combined clamps, are used to secure cables to beams, poles, or other structures. Fiber optic cable hangers, often made from stainless steel or UV-resistant polypropylene (PP) or ABS plastics, provide durability, water resistance, and fireproof properties. They can accommodate cable diameters typically ranging from 5 mm to 11 mm for optical fibers and up to 24 mm for power cables . **D-Rings:** These are used for organizing and routing fiber optic cables in equipment racks, telecommunication rooms, and data centers. D-rings help prevent tangling and maintain neat cable pathways . **Aerial Mounting Hardware:** For outdoor or overhead installations, aerial hardware such as suspension clamps, anchor tension clamps, and cable guy grips are used. These fittings support ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting) fiber optic cables on poles or towers, distributing tension evenly and minimizing bending stress. They are essential for long-span or angled installations and protect cables from environmental factors . **Holders and Clips:** Magnetic or adhesive-based holders and clips provide additional support for both indoor and outdoor applications. They can be used independently or in combination with other hanging hardware to ensure uniform cable management .
