

Formula for calculating the length of the fiber optic pigtail in the terminal box



Overview

Considering the bending radius and safety margin, the final pigtail length is calculated as follows: Straight-line distance: 2 meters Increase in cabling path: 1 meter Interface reserve: 0.5 meters $\times 2 = 1$ meter (one end of each device) Safety margin: 0.5 meters Fiber pigtails are short-distance connections between optical modules, optical terminals, optical distribution frames (ODFs) and other devices in optical fiber communication systems.
