

How to separate a distribution box into a control box

- Determine the voltage levels and ensure low-voltage control circuits (e.g., 12V, 24V) are physically separated from high-voltage circuits (e.g., 240V, 415V), .
- Select Appropriate Enclosures
- Choose a separate control box with proper IP/NEMA ratings for the environment.
- Ensure the distribution box and control box have sufficient space for future expansion .
