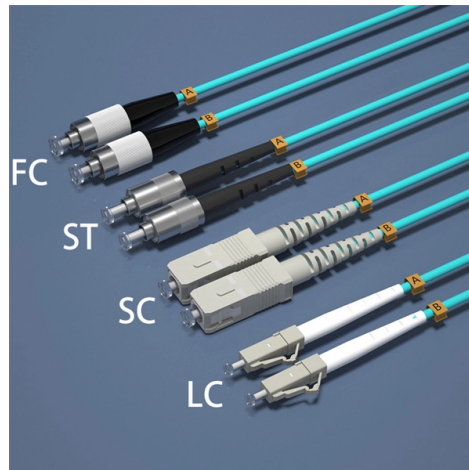


How to use a pigtail to lay fiber optic cable
