

Internal duct for laying optical cables



Overview

Optical cable is usually placed in a 25 to 40 mm inside diameter (ID) sub-duct which is placed into an existing larger diameter communications conduit. Most communications conduits can be fitted with three or four sub-ducts. Sub-ducts are often referred to as. ing and blowing a cable in a duct and the impact on the cable designs.
