A distribution board (also known as panelboard, circuit breaker panel, breaker panel, circuit breaker, electric panel, fuse box or DB box) is a component of an electricity supply system that divides an electrical power feed into subsidiary circuits while providing a protective fuse or circuit. Prior to the 2008 edition of the National Electrical Code (NEC), residential panels were limited to 42 circuits due to concerns about heat generation. This meant that a residential electrical panel could contain no more than 42 overcurrent devices for lighting and appliance branch circuits. Whether it's a small electrical.

North American distribution boards are generally housed in sheet metal enclosures, with the circuit breakers positioned in two columns operable from the front. Some panelboards are provided with a door covering the breaker switch handles, but all are constructed with a dead front; that is to say the front of the enclosure (whether it has a door or not) prevents the operator of the circuit breakers from contacting live electrical parts within. Busbars carry the current from incoming line (hot) conductors to the breakers

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
