

Multi-bandwidth aggregation via a switch



Overview

An aggregation switch is a network device that consolidates traffic from multiple access switches, wireless access points, or other edge devices and forwards it to core switches or routers. By bundling multiple network connections into a single high-bandwidth link, aggregation switches help. Switch-to-Switch Aggregation: This is useful in scenarios where you need to interconnect multiple switches to increase the bandwidth available between them and ensure network redundancy. It helps in managing higher traffic loads between switches. All the physical links in a Link Aggregation Group (LAG) must operate in full-duplex mode at the same speed. For example, two 10-gigabit Ethernet ports, one each from two MLAG configured switches, can connect to two 10-gigabit ports on a host, switch, or network device to create a link that. As devices are added to a small network, more switch ports are needed to connect those devices to the network.
