Outdoor Fiber Installation

Aerial installations attach the fiber to utility poles and run a service drop cable to the house .

Entry Methods into the Home

The fiber drop cable is the final link from the provider's network to the residence. Common entry methods include:

- Through a Wall: A small hole is drilled in an exterior wall, and the fiber is fed through a weatherproof grommet or sealant to prevent water and pest intrusion .
- Through an Existing Conduit: If a conduit for cable TV or telephone lines exists, the fiber can be pulled through it, avoiding new drilling .
