

PoE switch priority



Overview

Set the power priority for individual interfaces when there is insufficient power for all PoE interfaces. For a given level, ports are prioritized by port number in ascending order. If there is not enough power available to provision all active PoE. You can enable PoE, configure dynamic guard band, and set the priority power allocation for a specific port. The priority determines the order in which PoE is removed from ports if a power shortage occurs: low-priority, then high-priority, with power maintained for critical-priority ports. Assigns a power priority of low (the default), high, or critical to each enabled PoE port. A lower-numbered port has priority over a higher-numbered port within the same configured priority class, for

Configuring the PoE port priority

For chassis switches, the lowest-numbered port at that level starting with module A, then B, C, and so on is provisioned. PoE priorities are invoked only when all active PoE ports cannot be provisioned

The switch cannot provide enough power to each port, so it provides power according to the priority. The administrator sets the priority for each port, allocating how much power it can be given.

PoE priority example: Given: A 48 port switch is supplying a total of 375 watts. The administrator configures all ports to allocate up to 30 watts. This results in 48 times 30 ports equaling 1440 watts,
