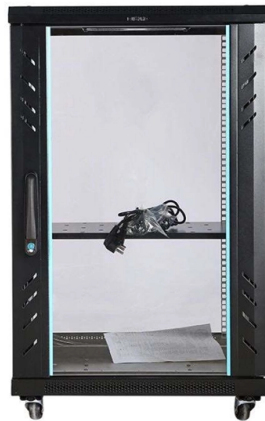


Replace fiber optic cable with network cable

You can replace a fiber optic cable with a network cable connection by using a fiber-to-Ethernet media converter or a fiber network adapter.

Using a Media Converter

A fiber media converter allows you to connect a fiber optic cable to a standard Ethernet network (Cat5e/Cat6). The process involves:

- Install SFP transceivers: Insert the correct SFP or SFP+ transceivers into the media converter ports. These transceivers convert optical signals to electrical signals compatible with Ethernet .
- Connect the fiber cable: Plug the fiber optic cable into the SFP transceiver. Ensure the cable is not bent beyond the manufacturer's recommended radius to prevent signal loss .
- Connect the Ethernet cable: Use a standard RJ45 network cable to connect the media converter to your network switch, router, or computer .
- Power and test: Power on the media converter and verify connectivity using network testing tools or by checking link lights on the devices .
