

The upstream switch of the distribution box



Overview

In a dual-RCD or RCBO board, the main switch is upstream of all other devices. In some configurations, the main switch also serves as the RCD (a main switch RCD or RCCB), but this is less common in modern boards because a fault on any circuit would trip the main. The distribution board is the heart of every electrical installation.
