

What are the specifications for the incoming lines of a distribution box

In some designs, a 4-pin circuit breaker may be used, where three-phase lines and neutral enter together, and the ground is connected separately.

Electrical Ratings

The incoming line must match the rated current and breaking capacity of the main protective device. This ensures safe operation under normal load and during short-circuit conditions. The line type, voltage rating (e.g., 220V single-phase or 380V three-phase), and conductor cross-section are selected based on the total load and expected fault current.
