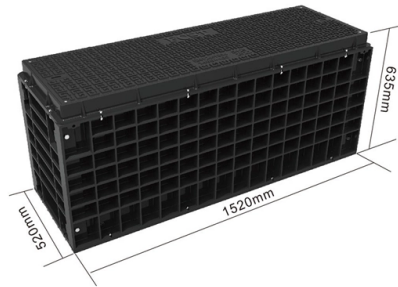


What is an optical port in a switch

Types of Optical Ports

Optical ports typically accommodate optical modules (like SFP, SFP+, QSFP) that transmit data over fiber. Common speeds include 1.25G, 10G, 25G, 40G, 100G, and higher, with transmission distances ranging from a few meters to over 100 kilometers depending on the fiber type and module. Optical ports can also support different connector types, such as LC, SC, MPO, and in some hybrid setups, even RJ45 modules for copper connections.

Advantages of Optical Ports

- **High-speed transmission:** Optical ports support much higher speeds than traditional Ethernet ports, often exceeding 100G.
