

What is the national standard wall thickness for cable trays

- Nonmetallic (Fiberglass/FRP) Cable Trays:

- Thickness is specified under UL 568 and NEMA FG-1, generally ranging from 3 mm to 6 mm, depending on tray width, span, and load requirements .
